In 2018, Turtle Ranch began breeding Clyde X horses. We retained the first two foals for our own use to evaluate the potential of this new bloodline. The results have been outstanding; these horses exhibit remarkable gentleness and maturity for their age.

Turtle horses are bred at an altitude of 7,000 feet and foaled in stables. They are handled and halter-broken before being turned out to pasture with their mothers. At six months, they are weaned and then released into the ranch's mountainous terrain of Wyoming to grow and develop naturally.
